

Zone K Committee Meeting

Reviewed results of survey. Approximately 50% responded. Of those, 62% were not in favor of meters at this time or supported 'wait and see.' All present voted to not request meters in Zone K at this time. The committee would continue to monitor on-street parking as changes are implemented in the areas around Zone K.

The survey results showed a majority of responders supported keeping the laminated guest permits and the one day scratch-off permits, but limiting the amount of one day scratch-off permits any address can purchase. All voted to formally request the city limit the amount of scratch-off permits that each address purchase to 50 (5 books; 10 permits per book) per year in Zone K, and that the city establish a rule that an address can only sell a single day scratch-off permit one day at a time.

Zone K committee member Rich Durant is no longer a property owner or resident of the Zone. There is now an open position on the committee. Fellow committee members will search for willing and interested candidates.
